

FLIPPED CLASSROOM

About Flipped Classroom Methodology:

As every good student has followed it forever, the classroom interaction between students and teacher becomes multi-fold better if the students have read a little about the topic before coming to the class. But given the lack of interest for reading books, and unavailability of the feature to make books personalized to every student, students normally give it a skip. With the advent of technology, flipped classrooms have emerged as the most efficient way of teaching in the class and is being followed by the leaders in education, like Harvard, Stanford, IIMs etc. In this methodology, students are given the theory in the form of videos/animations/texts etc. that the students go through at their own space and comfort while at home, whereas teachers tackle the understanding in the class by doing problem solving, experiments, refutations, revisions etc. in the class. This helps the students, as they are now able to engage with the teacher in the classroom, which isn't possible in the traditional classroom setup due to one-way delivery and limited time. Also, if a student isn't clear of the concept, or has missed a class, he can go back to the video books and learn the concept, without asking for any remedial from the teacher.
