We, the students of Class VII make an appeal close to our heart. Every year the class VII students have conducted a traffic project near University Chowk, wherein we have tried to educate the public on traffic rules and why following them is beneficial to us.

However, this year we realized the problem is much closer to home. To analyze further, we conducted a survey right outside our school during the morning and afternoon hours to assess the traffic situation. It was found that most of us who come by private vehicles were not following the rules and thus the urge to appeal to all of you.

Observation during morning hours:

The Orchid School has provisioned for 2 drop off zones wherein students can be dropped off every morning, however it was noticed that many parents avoided the drop off zone and parked their cars haphazardly.

Observation during afternoon hours:

In the afternoon, it was noticed that the parents did not park their vehicles properly. There was 3 lane parking too, at many locations.

During both observations, it was noticed that many parents and children did not wear the helmet or the seat belt. Some also drove on the footpath or the opposite side of the road thus obstructing smooth flow of traffic.
