

WORKSHOP ON" PERFORMANCE STANDARDS AND SCHOOL INDICATORS"

A two day Workshop on" Performance standards and school indicators" will be held on 31st May and 1st June 2016 for the teaching staff followed with a half-day session for the Leaders on 2nd June 2016 by Ms. Anitha Jagathkar.

The course focuses on the performance indicators of successful schools which are used worldwide. Emphasis will be laid on evidence based judgements of indicators that will help the schools in analyzing strengths and weaknesses of different areas and the drafting of improvement plans for each and every indicator. Key aspects of each and every performance indicator will be discussed which will help the participants in understanding the key aspects that make a good school and also help them in reflecting their school's performance vis a vis international standards.

A brief profile of the facilitator:

Ms. Anitha Jagathkar has a Fellowship degree in education, Master degrees in Zoology and Social Work and a Cambridge diploma in teaching and training. Her experience includes roles as an education consultant, principal, leadership and teacher trainer on interactive resource based teaching. She has authored several baseline reports and drafted school development plans for both public and private schools. She led the assessment and Whole School Improvement Programme of CBSE and other state curriculum schools to improve instruction and student outcomes. She was the lead researcher for evaluating the impact of education interventions for a project funded by World Bank. She has developed the assessment framework and instruments for lesson observation during schools accreditation and inspection. As a team inspector she has inspected over 75 schools in UAE.
