

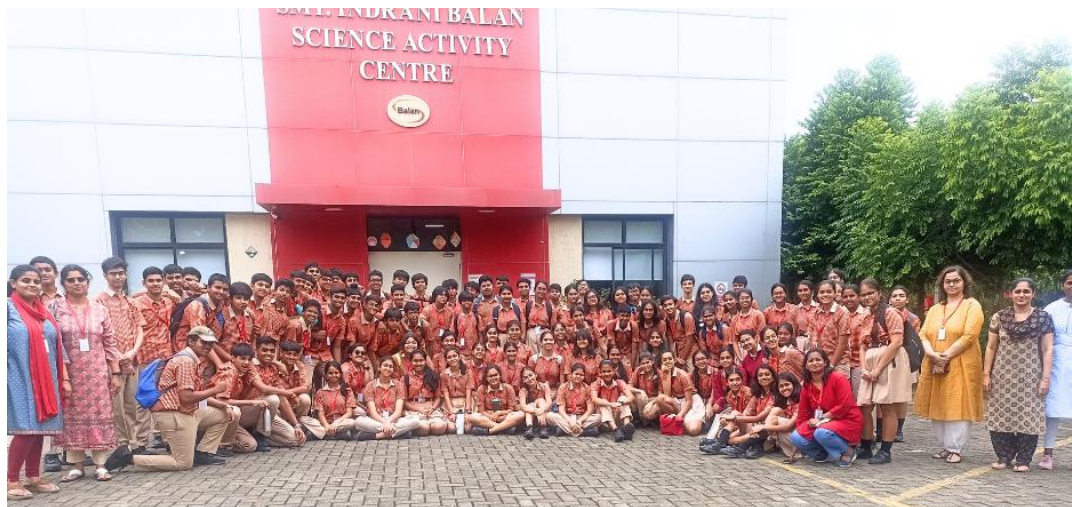
Field Trip to Indian Institute of Science, Education and Research
