




Community program for class VI with Akanksha foundation at APMS

Jeena Parekh – VI Aquamarine

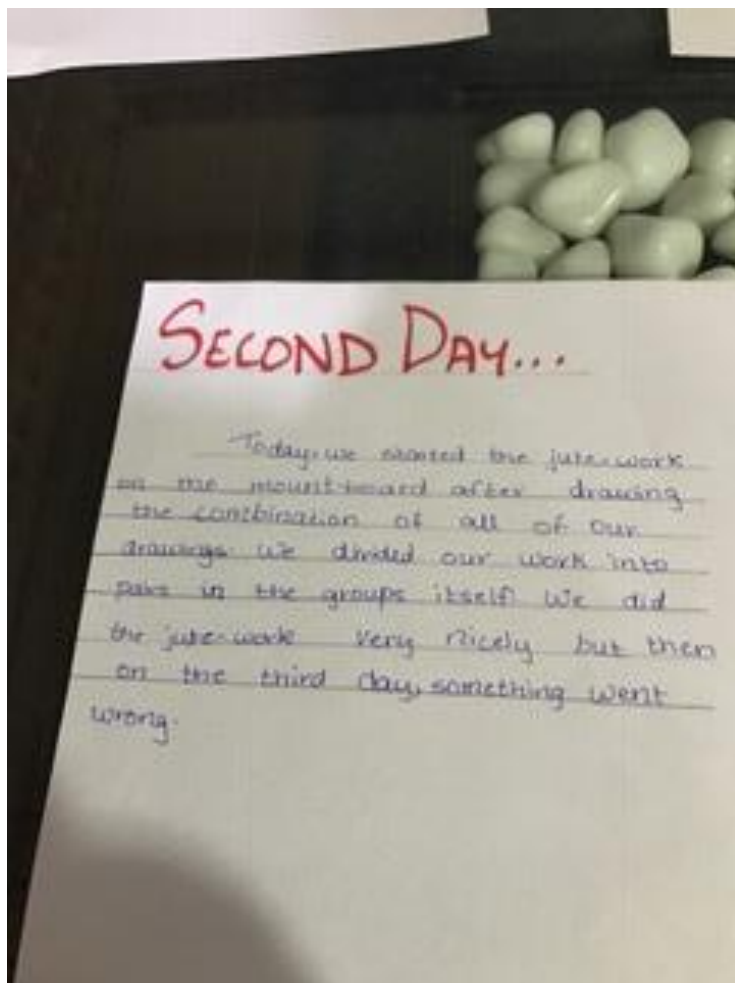
	
1. :- Hi, This is Jeena Parekh from VI Aquamarine. We all had visited a school. We had done a different art form with different people.
