


The Orchid School Parent Feedback Analysis for the Year 2022-2023




Objectives of Parent Feedback

- This survey is based on 227 parents i.e. approx. 30% of the parent population based on the fact that 30% of our parents have 2 children in the school.


My child likes what he / she is learning in school. 227 responses




My child's learning needs are being met by the teachers. 227 responses



My child is prepared for the next grade level by the end of the school year. 227 responses




The teaching at the school emphasizes on joyful and experiential learning. 227 responses





The teachers assess students in varied ways to measure the attainment through pen and paper assessment, projects, presentations, etc.






My child's teachers have informed me about the class activities and its purpose. 227 responses




During SPTC and other meetings, teachers have addressed any issue with regards to academics if any concerning my child.


My child feels happy to attend school.




My child feels comfortable to share his/her feelings freely in school with the teachers. 227 responses




The school provides adequate first aid intervention if my child gets sick or injured. 227 responses




The school promotes healthy socio-emotional environment for each student. 227 responses




The school staff genuinely show that they care about my child. 227 responses



My child's school teacher/ mentor reached out to her/him for her/his mental well being. 227 responses




The school offers opportunities for my child to participate in physical fitness activities. 227 responses




The co scholastic program offered to my child catered to his/her interests and talents (visual art, dance, sports, music).










I have the opportunity to express my views (if required) in key decisions about my child's education. 227 responses




There is a culture of continuous improvement at the school. 227 responses




The school continually seeks ways to improve programs to increase student's holistic progress. 227 responses
