This is to inform you that the selection trials for participation in the **CBSE Games 2026** will be conducted in the school for the following team sports events. The trial schedule is mentioned below:

- Cricket – Tuesday, 2nd June 2026 (Under-14 & Under-19)
- Basketball – Wednesday, 3rd June 2026 (Under-17 & Under-19)
- Football – Thursday, 4th June 2026 (Under-19)
- Athletics – Friday, 5th June 2026 (Under-14, Under-17 & Under-19)

The morning practice sessions for volleyball have already started. The final team selection will be done by the coaches based on the students' performance during these practice sessions.

Important Guidelines for CBSE Games Trials and Participation

1. Students are requested to be present on the scheduled trial date. As the selection process follows a predefined timeline, no alternate trial date will be provided for students who remain absent.
2. Selection of participants will be based solely on the performance demonstrated during the trials and subsequent practice sessions.

3. The decision of the coaches and the selection committee will be final and binding. We request parents and students to refrain from making individual requests or recommendations regarding team selection.
4. Attendance at all practice sessions will be mandatory for students selected for team events, as regular participation is essential for team preparation and performance.
5. Once a student's registration for the CBSE Games has been completed, they will be expected to represent the school and will not be permitted to withdraw from participation except under exceptional circumstances.
6. Students are requested to report punctually for the trials in appropriate sports attire and carry any sport-specific equipment that may be required.

We look forward to enthusiastic participation and wish all students the very best for the selection trials.
