Points discussed:

- Director-Principal highlighted that the school's **CBSE SQAA score of 9.3 in 2026** reflects the institution's sustained commitment to quality and continuous improvement. She noted that this achievement represents a 35% improvement over the past three years and has earned the school recognition on the CBSE national platform.
- She shared the exemplary board results of class X and XII and growth in the new enrollments in class XI reflecting the increase in community trust and institutional reputation.
- List of academic programs were shared with the EPTA emphasizing the need of skills beyond traditional classrooms.
- Dr. Namrata Majhail shared that 'Dharohar' has been selected as the theme for the upcoming Founders' Day celebration. The EPTA members were also apprised that Sneha Shankar will be the featured artist performer for the event.
- The Director- Principal emphasized the importance of aligning literacy and numeracy through experiential learning and progressive competency building. She highlighted the need to strengthen foundational skills by integrating hands-on, real-world learning experiences for the preprimary domain.
- It was stated that each activity included in the academic calendar is purposefully designed to progressively build student competencies. She emphasized that this structured progression ensures holistic student growth and supports meaningful, age-appropriate learning experiences.
- The Director- Principal informed the members that LogIQids, CS Soch, Eduten, and STEM-based learning programs were implemented across Grades I–IV, supported by continuous monitoring of student progress and active collaboration with parents to strengthen learning outcomes.
- A structured support system comprising remediation cycles, small-group reinforcement, and parallel support programs was implemented to bridge learning gaps through differentiated and multisensory methodologies for the primary domain students.
- Three targeted programs — Asset Assessment, Mylein Assessment, and Open Door Assessment — have been implemented for Classes V–VIII to strengthen competency-based assessment across English, Mathematics, and Science.
- For the students of Senior Secondary domain programs such as Future Fluencies, Path 2 Possibilities, Internship Fair, and the TED-Ed Club have been designed to prepare students for a rapidly changing world by fostering essential future-ready skills, developing a sense of purpose, and enhancing real-world readiness.
- It was emphasized that a rich blend of leadership, cultural, artistic, and global learning opportunities is being provided to nurture well-rounded, engaged, and socially responsible students.
- It was proposed that future meeting invitations be shared through Google Calendar. The suggestion was accepted and agreed upon by all members present.
- An Invite was extended to all PTA members for the three days celebration of the 22nd Founders Day.
- The meeting concluded with a thanking all the members for being a part of EPTA.
